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

#### Regulatory Environment Ease of Doing Business: 2016-2018












#### Operating Risks Terrorism


- Egypt faces severe terrorist threats especially from extremist outfits such as Daesh-Sinai

- Many more things happen...




#### Education and Skills Higher Education Rates 2011 and 2016



#### **Employment and Labour Costs**

- Both the unemployment and youth unemployment rate have increased between 2011 and 2017 (11.5%). The country's new economic plan targets at bringing down the unemployment rate to 10.9% by end of 2018 and subsequently to less than 9% by mid-2020;
- The wage per hour in manufacturing has declined between 2015 and 2016 and was the lowest within the region.
